DP Ruler 2 Itzamnaaj K'awiil

DP Ruler 3 u-Cha'n-u() K'in-Bahlam (captor of K'in Bahlam), a military figure and regent until Ruler 4;
when became regent gained an additional first part of name, "scroll-head" nickname

DP Ruler 4 K'awiil Chan K'inich

Seibal has older history, but that was destroyed when conquered.

Seibal conquered by Dos Pilas in 735 = 9.15.4.6.4

(after that DP ruler 3 prefers the second type of DP emblem glyph)

Seibal hieroglyphic stairs 9.15.13.13.0 to 9.16.0.0.0

Seibal hosted one of rival Petexbatun kings 771 to 800(+)

Seibal refounded by Aj Bolon Haabtal (or Abtal), who arrived in 830 = 9.19.19.17.19,

supervised by Chan Ek' Hopet "Aj K'anwitznal" ('he of Ucanal')

Aj Bolon Haabtal celebrated the 10.1.0.0.0 period ending in 849
